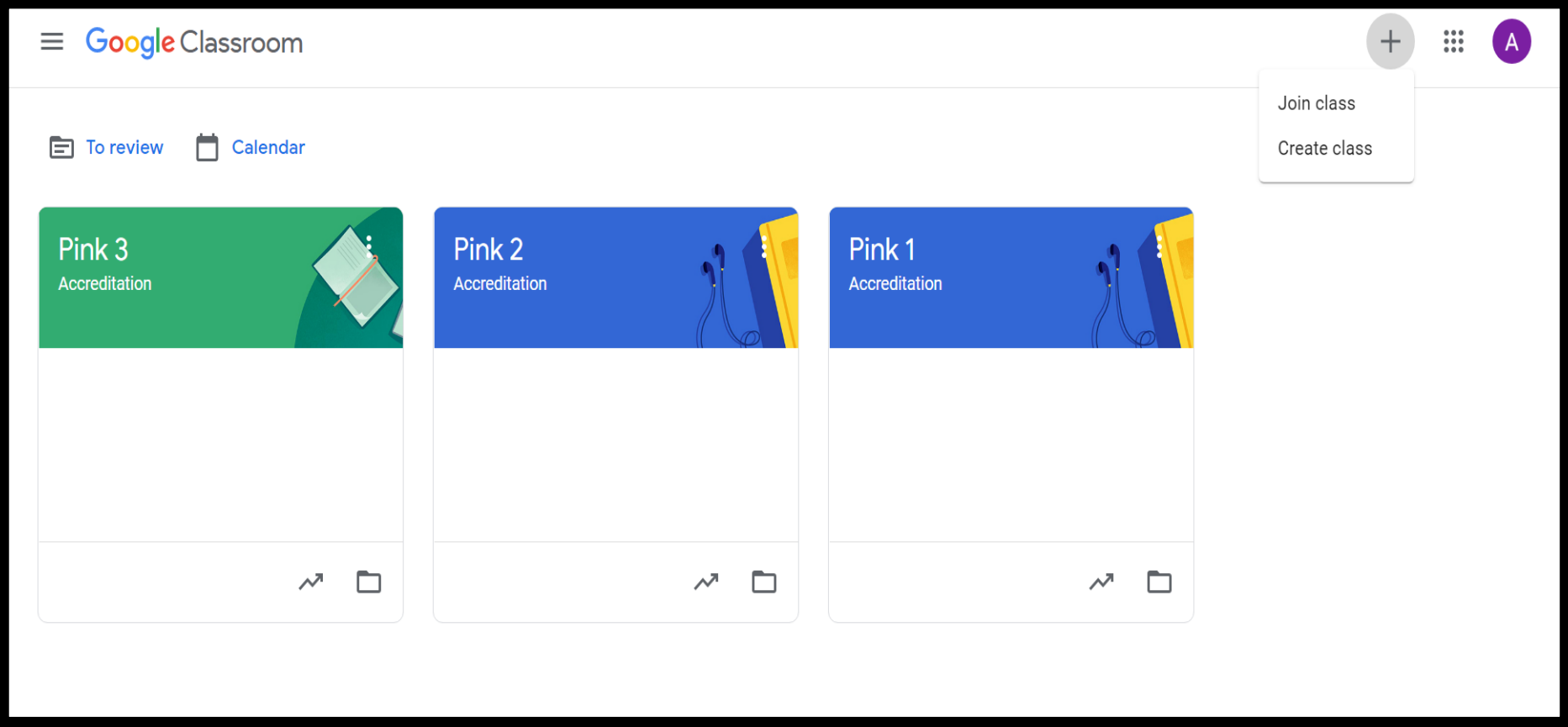
Once registered and logged in - click on the 9 dots, and scroll down till you find 'Google Classrooms' and click.

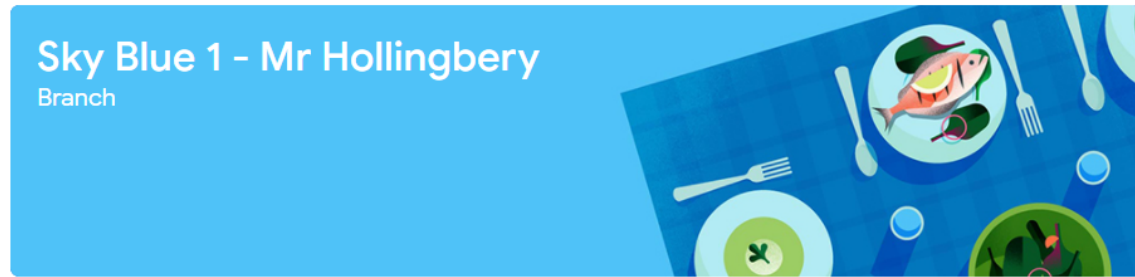

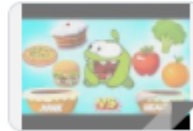


