We are learning:

- All single sounds at speed

- Common word meanings and spellings that use the sounds they have learnt
- To write and read red words (words that are not phonetically spelt)
- To read basic sentences and building on their vocabulary

We will focus on:

- Beginning to write independently
- Extending vocabulary
- Writing... invitations, recounts, instructions and narrative
- Introducing use of capital letters and full stops to be using correctly as well as understanding the use of a conjunction

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Art, Design and Religious Education

We will focus on :

- Where food comes from
- How to make basic foods

- Creating and debugging simple programs
