## Writing:

We will focus on:

- Recounts.
- Labels and Captions.
- Adventure Narrative.
- Instructions.
- Character Study.



## Maths:

We are learning:

- Count to ten, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.
- Count, read and write numbers to 10 in numerals and words.
- Given a number, identify one more or one less.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.

## Science:

We will focus on:

- Distinguishing between an object and the material from which it is made.
- Investigating different materials.
- Using observation and ideas to suggest answers to questions.



Art, ICT and Design and Technology:

- Explore and use mechanisms (e.g. levers, sliders), in our products.
- Build structures, exploring how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable.
- Find out where food comes from.
- Design purposeful, functional, appealing products based on a design criteria.
- Select and use a range of materials and components, including construction materials, textiles and ingredients, according to their characteristics.
- Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.
- Understand what algorithms are, how they are implemented as programs on digital devices, and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instruction.

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## PSHE

We are learning:

- To recognise what we like and dislike, what is fair and unfair, and what is right and wrong.
- To share opinions on things that matter to pupils and explain our views.
- To recognise, name and deal with our feelings in a positive way.
- To think about ourselves, learn from our experiences and recognise what we are good at.
- To take part in discussions with one another and the whole class.
- To take part in a simple debate about topical issues.

## RE

We are learning:

- About some ways in which we belong and why belonging is important.
- To identify the importance for some people of belonging to a religion and the difference it makes to their lives.



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## History and Geography:

We will focus on:

- Learning about events beyond living memory such as The Great Fire of London.
- Countries and capital cities of the UK (London focus).
- Using locational language.
- Using maps.
- Geographical similarities.
