Year 1 Phonics Screening Test



• All children in Year 1 throughout the country will be taking part in a phonics screening check.

• The phonics screening test will take place in the week of the 10th June.

The Phonics Screening Test

 The phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether individual children have learned phonic decoding and blending skills to an appropriate standard.

What happens during the screening?

- The test contains 40 words. Each child will sit one-toone and read each word aloud.
- The test will take approximately 10 minutes, but the test takes as long as the child needs.

The test

- The list of words consists of 20 real words and 20 pseudo words (nonsense words).
- The pseudo words are shown with pictures of aliens so that the children will know they are nonsense.
- Pseudo words are included as they are new to all children.




