Dear Parents/Carers,

Major infrastructure work is now underway as part of key planned improvements to Barking Riverside. These include the Overground Station and Barking Riverside Pier; new school access; and the next phase of development regarding the Wellbeing Hub.

This means that Project Road and Fielders Crescent will be closed as a through route from 20th September 2021 to enable the upgrade works to take place. This will impact local bus routes as well as access to Riverside Campus.

The construction work will take place in different phases. Phase I has already concluded, and there has been temporary one-way traffic control outside of Riverside Campus. This was installed during summer and has recently been removed.

The phase 2 works, which are due to begin on 20^{th} September, are more significant and will cause greater impact to local journeys.

3. How do I getting my child to school/nursery if the road is closed?

There will be no drop-off and collection points available to cars during this period. Parents are recommended to use alternative travel means such as public transport.

4. What will happen to the bus routes?

The ELI and EL3 routes will terminate earlier on Project Road, junction with River Road. The EL2 route will remain as normal.

5. Where can I see the programme of works?

The latest programme of works is available to view on the website.

6. I live along Fielders Crescent — how will I drive to my home if Project Road is closed?

The car route will be Renwick Rd, right into Choats Rd and right again into Northgate Road. Please visit the BRL website for the latest transport updates relating to the road closures and diversions in place.
