

This half term, we have been looking at significant people for our topic, Movers and Shakers. Below are your homework projects. Please choose at least one to be completed and brought to school by **Friday 10th November 2023**.

Biography

Write a biography about a historically significant person who lived in the past. It can be someone you have learned about in class, or it could be someone who lived in your local area. Write about this person's life and why we remember them today. You can use information books or the internet to help you.

Timeline

Becoming a significant person is not easy. Neil Armstrong, for example, had to work hard to become an astronaut before he had the opportunity to travel to the Moon. Research and create a timeline of Neil Armstrong's education and training, beginning after he left school and ending with the Moon landing.

Categorising Significant People

Historically significant people can be divided into five groups: activists, artists, explorers, monarchs, and scientists.

Can you write a definition for each of these groups, and find an example of each one?

For example, Neil Armstrong was an explorer.

Portraits

Using a range of materials, can you create either a 3D model of a historically significant person, or a painting of them. Try and make your model or painting as detailed as possible. Once you have created your piece of artwork, can you write a short description of who your historically significant person is, and why they are important.
