<u>Timeline</u>

Create a timeline to put the following periods of prehistory into chronological order: Bronze Age, Iron Age and Stone Age (including the three periods of the Stone Age: Neolithic, Palaeolithic and Mesolithic).

Poster

Use a range of sources to find out about one of these aspects of Stone Age life: settlements, food, clothing, tools, and weapons. Use your research to create an information poster about your chosen aspect. Include images to make your information poster interesting.

Detailed illustration

The Iron Age people of Britain, known as the Celts, were fearsome warriors. Use your existing knowledge and research to draw a detailed illustration of a Celtic warrior and write a short paragraph to describe their beliefs, clothing, weapons and warfare.
