Copious (Etymology - Latin *copiosus* "plentiful")

Word Class: Adjective

Meaning: abundant in supply or quantity.

Example: 1. He was able to support his argument with copious reasoning.

- 2. After receiving **copious** letters from viewers, the TV network revived the cancelled show.
- 3. It has a year-long mild climate, **copious** supplies of fresh water, vegetation and trees that contain plenty of good things to eat.
- 4. The copious quantities of salt in this product are unlikely to help his blood pressure.
