### Syllabus Details

AQA level 3 extended project qualification.

#### **Assessment**

The evidence for assessment will comprise of a completed production log and the project product. The project product can include a written report and any other evidence, as appropriate, depending on the subject area chosen

## Requirements

All year 12 students undertaking three A levels can additionally complete an EPQ.

### **Key Stage 5 Overview**

#### **Course Content**

The Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) gives students the opportunity to develop their planning, organisational, project management and presentation skills. Students can select their own research topic of choice and produce a piece of independent work. This work will be guided and overseen by the teacher.

### Amongst other topics students study the following:

- Research skills including the ability to search for and identify suitable sources of information.
- ICT skills that will enhance the production of the report and/or the development of the project.
- Project management skills including time, resource and task management.
- The format and structure of accepted academic forms of research report.
- Referencing, the evaluation of sources and the prevention of plagiarism.
- Presentation skills.

## Year 12 Topics

- Autumn Term Synthesising a research question and planning of project.
- Spring Term Researching, referencing and evaluating sources.
- Summer Term I Implementing plan and producing EPQ product (research report or artefact).
- Summer Term 2 Finalising and evaluating EPQ project.
