## **Re: Year 11 Mock Examinations**

As you know, your son/daughter's mock GCSE exams will commence in the new half-term. They will last from Monday 13th November until Friday 24th November. A copy of the mock timetable has been provided for your reference.

### **Before mocks**

Students should ensure that they are revising in order to prepare for their mocks. Students have created a revision timetable that they are expected to follow during the half-term holiday, please support your son/daughter in following their revision timetable. Students have also received revision materials before half-term from their class teachers to support them.

#### **During mocks**

From Monday 13<sup>th</sup>, interventions and independent study from 3-4pm will be paused. Students may have multiple exams on one day and should use this time to prepare and consolidate their knowledge for their next day's exams. Year 11 detentions will run from 3pm to 4pm during this time.

Please ensure your son/daughter has all necessary equipment ahead of their mock exams, including spare pens/pencils and a working scientific calculator, if required for their exams. Stationery will not be provided to students who arrive lacking equipment.

We must also impress upon parents and students the importance of good attendance and punctuality, particularly during examination periods. To help prepare students, they will be held to the same expectations as for their final examinations whereby students are expected to attend school for the purpose of sitting their exams **even if ill with a minor illness such as sickness or a cold.** 

### After mocks

On Monday 27th November, students will return to their usual timetable with independent study, intervention and detention arrangements returning to normal. If students do not attend, usual consequences will apply.
