<p>Nuffield placements Scientific research</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 – 6 week placements over the summer holidays, usually in university research facilities • Over 1,000 placements each year, working alongside professional scientists, technologists, engineers and mathematicians • Probably the most highly regarded experience for would-be science and engineering students • Highly competitive, but no particular grades required.
